
MATERIAL SOURCING STANDARD

It is our responsibility to manage the risks of harmful environmental impacts during the procurement of materials and components.

By making specific and informed choices in our sourcing of materials, we can lower the environmental impact of our gear. Our *Material Sourcing Standard* defines the requirements that must be met by both our Melbourne and international partner factories.

We prioritise Australian made and local suppliers first. Where possible, we complete secondary and unique batch audits in collaboration with our suppliers, and regularly make personal visits.

In all cases, we aim to develop long-term relationships with suppliers and mills, specifying the importance of low-impact production.

ONE PLANET will not tolerate any human or animal rights abuse in our business or supply chain.

Sourcing of textiles and componentry

When purchasing from textile and component suppliers, we prioritise **Oeko-tex** and/or **Bluesign** certifications.

Ethically sourced down

Our down is ethically sourced as a by-product from the food/meat industry. Within our supply chain, we only source from certified facilities, and then audit every down batch with the **IDFL** (international Down and Feather Laboratory).

In our Melbourne factory, we consciously only hold our audited batches of down, ensuring there is no chance of cross contamination.

Sustainable leather sourcing

Although leather is seen as a by-product of the meat industry, we're committed to ensuring our supply chain is sustainable and accountable through our *Ethical Sourcing Standards*.

Our Material Sourcing Standard is employed in conjunction with our *Standard of Manufacturing*, and we're proud to manufacture the majority of ONE PLANET equipment in Melbourne, Australia.
